The Chickasaw Foundation is very proud to offer funding assistance for college. After completing this page and the attached application, and providing us with the required documentation, your application shall be reviewed for consideration of funding. All applicants shall complete the application and provide the appropriate documentation. **Incomplete applications and/or applications lacking appropriate support documentation shall not be considered.**

All scholarship funding begins with each fall semester and is dependent upon the availability of funding. Scholarship awards shall be made payable directly to the student's designated college or university. If a student is awarded a scholarship from the Chickasaw Foundation, the Foundation does not stipulate how the scholarship funds sent to a college or university are to be used, and it is up to the individual to be aware of any tax considerations or issues. The award requirements and amounts for each funding source may change during the course of a school year. **All scholarship applications and supporting documentation shall be delivered or postmarked by the stated deadline date – June 1, 2023 at 5 p.m. CST– to be considered for funding.**

***Note:** Eligibility for receipt of the second disbursement of a two-part scholarship award (spring semester) shall be contingent upon remaining in full-time status and maintaining the minimum GPA requirement (based on preceding fall semester GPA). In the event any scholarship recipient is placed on academic probation or is found to be guilty of misconduct, the recipient forfeits the scholarship award regardless of GPA requirement. Students enrolled in online classes will be eligible to be considered for a scholarship award as long as the classes are associated with an accredited college or university.

All letters and emails detailing missing documents are sent to students as a courtesy. It is the ultimate responsibility of the student to ensure that applications and documentation are received or postmarked by established deadlines. Any dispute over student eligibility shall be decided by the Chickasaw Foundation. The decision by the Chickasaw Foundation shall be final.

All application materials, as well as the application process, are confidential and applicants cannot obtain an accounting of the process, their application, or copies of their application or materials once submitted.

Nothing contained herein may be construed to waive the sovereign rights of the Chickasaw Nation, its officers, employees, or agents.

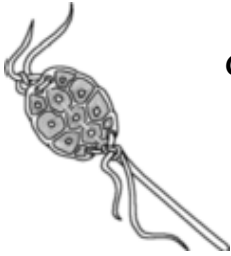
